## Jane Brodd: A Tripoli Treasure

Jane Brodd is an inspiration and joy to fellow Tripoli Golfers. Jane is known for making everyone feel at home on the golf course, regardless of skill level. Jane’s motto? “Never be serious about golf. It’s a past-time.” These are words Jane lives by and practices on the course whenever she can. As just one example, Reece Peterson jokes, “Jane doesn’t putt. If it’s close, it’s good.” She is also well known for singing songs with bawdry lyrics of her day including *Roll me Over in the Clover* for everyone’s amusement.

At the same time, Jane is an accomplished golfer with six Hole-in-Ones! Two occurred at Tripoli in 1984 on Tee 7 and Tee 12. Jane was a member of the Tripoli District Team for a remarkable 50 years. She also won Tripoli’s esteemed Women’s Club Championship 15 times between 1953 and

1973. Being a good sport, Jane finally decided to “let someone else win” with her typical good humor. The annual Best 2 out of 3 Scores Low Net Tournament held in July is now named in Jane’s honor for her contribution to Tripoli Golf through her sportsmanship, athletic achievements and love of the game.

Her first experience with golf began in the early 1930’s when Jane’s parents, George and Helen Levis, joined Tripoli through his employer. Jane along with her twin sister Georganne learned golf at the Club as mere first-graders. A few years after Jane wed Lawrence Brodd in 1951, they established their own Membership. Jane and Laurie golfed together at Tripoli every Sunday. Their son Bill and wife Tracy joined in 1984, the third generation of TCC Membership.

Recently, the Tripoli Board of Governors presented an Honorary Membership to Mrs. Lawrence (Jane) Brodd making her one of only three Honorary Members in the history of the Club. The 2010 Women’s Association President Nancy Berg will pay tribute to Jane Brodd during the Women’s Wind-Up Luncheon on Wednesday, September 8th.
