From the Golf Pro

Pace of play is always a topic at any golf course. Often when rangers, golfers will tell me that they are not being pushed by the group behind. So, there is no reason to play fast. One thing to remember is that pace of play has nothing to do with the group behind you but everything to do with keeping pace with the group ahead of you. Let us all enjoy the day at the golf course and be considerate to the other golfers and Members at Tripoli. Follow these three simple rules and all will go well with your pace of play:

1. No more than two hours per nine holes of play or four hours for 18 holes. The foursome and players are responsible for keeping up and knowing how much time the group is taking to play.
2. Should you come to a tee box and notice that the group ahead of you has already put the flagstick back in the hole, you are falling behind and should close the gap.
3. On weekend and holiday play, foursomes that play before 8:00 AM are expected to play golf in no more than a 3-hour and 45-minute pace. This sets the tone for the entire play (and sometimes golfer's happiness at Tripoli) after that time.

To ensure that everyone has an enjoyable round of golf, groups that are behind pace may be approached by the golf shop staff. We cannot be out there all the time but we will do our best during the busy times. Please remember, the players are responsible for keeping up. If you know you may be slower than the field of play, tee off at off times. I can ensure that your day will be more enjoyable.

Finally, help take care of your Club and the golf course by fixing your ball marks, rake your sand traps, replace your divots and keep golf carts at least 30 feet away from the greens and tees. Terry Conway and his grounds crew have kept the course in great shape and it is important that golfers do these helpful things during the course of play. Thanks for your cooperation.

Junior Golf Updates

Many thanks to the scorers for their help in Tripoli's Junior Program. Without them we wouldn't have golf for the Juniors. Your continued help on Tuesdays is greatly appreciated and hasn't gone unnoticed. Thanks again, for all that you do! On another note, 9-hole Junior District is off and running. If you have any interest in playing in a Junior District Event, please notify the golf staff. Junior District is a great way to have your Junior play some of the top area golf courses.

There's an option for scorers that's gaining in popularity. Hire an 18 Holer to score for you. It seems to be a win for everyone. Parents don't have to score or hire a babysitter and our older Juniors have an opportunity to earn some extra money. The cost is \$25 per scoring duty. Let Mike Miesen know if you're interested.

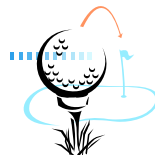

On the very top right of the home page, you’ll see a place to enter your username and password.

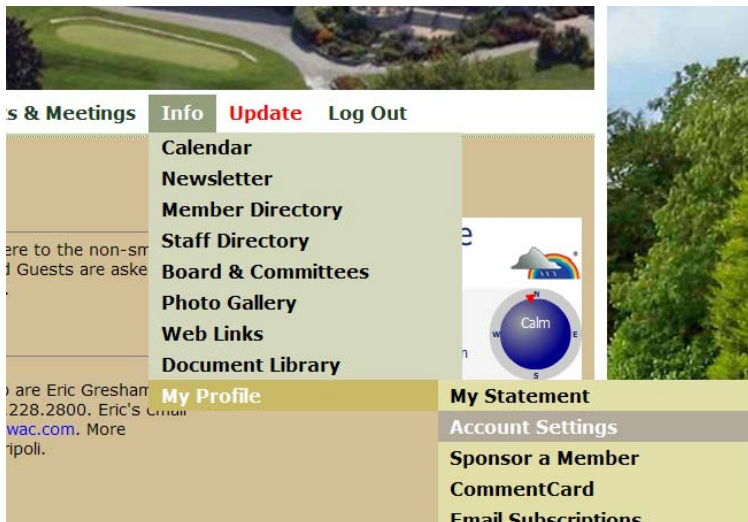
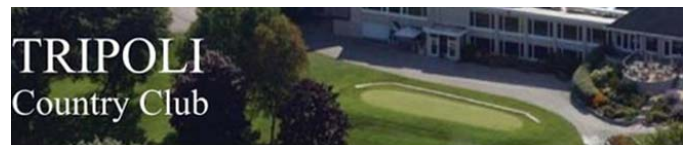
Your username is the main Member’s first initial and last name (i.e. jsmith). The default password is your membership number.
